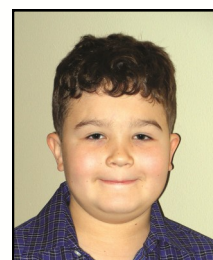

Food Services

Since the closure of Municipal Auditorium and AT&T's departure, the neighborhood around our church has changed dramatically. The result has been recurring and significant losses for the Café. At the same time, the Tobin Center has initiated discussions with the church to consider development of a parking solution for the Tobin Center on all properties owned by the church along 4th street.

Following Fred Neighbors' resignation and the Tobin Center's interest, the SLT and church leadership believe that the wisest course of action is to allow the Café to close on December 21st pursuant to the normal schedule and to remain closed to see how discussions with the Tobin Center proceed.

This will give us the opportunity to reorganize church food services to include improved quality of service, expanded volunteer opportunities and exercise disciplined stewardship of church resources.

The church will keep its funding commitment to the SA Food Bank and Haven for Hope in 2013 regardless of the Café's status.
