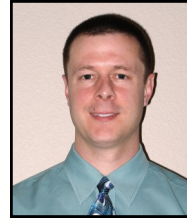

Church Conference

Join us in Church Conference on Sunday, February 24, 2013, at 5:30PM in Fellowship Hall, just prior to Time for Teaching at 6:00 pm in the Chapel.

The Church met in Church Conference on January 27, 2013, with Manny Ruiz moderating.

Finance Report: Mark Howard, Finance Committee chair, presented the December statements. Support & Revenue exceeded Expenses in 2012 by \$215,000, a significant turnaround from the prior year.

Building Fund Report: Mark Howard, Finance Committee Chair, and Gardner Peavy, Building & Property Chair, reported that all Building Fund projects begun in 2012 have been completed. Total cost was \$92,000 under budget. The Building Fund currently has \$765,000 on deposit.

FBC Foundation: Mark Schmeltekopf, Board Chair for the Foundation, reported that the Foundation's focus is church member awareness. Videos will be presented to the Church that highlight members who contributed to create an enduring legacy of support for Church ministries. The Foundation's investment balance is \$1.2 million, as of December 31, 2012.

Committee on Committees Recommendations: Recommendations presented by Eric Greer, Committee on Committees Chair, were approved for Service and Ministry Teams and Church Representatives for the FBC Foundation, San Antonio Baptist Association, and Trustees.

Deacon Nominating Committee Recommendations: Richard Elliott, Deacon Nominating Committee Chair in 2012, presented a supplemental write-in ballot of Active Deacons for 2013. The motion was approved and the deacons on the ballot were elected.

Seminary Recommendation: The Church approved Pastor Don Guthrie's endorsement of Dan Franklin to attend Logsdon Seminary.
