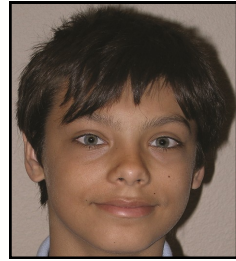

Moving Forward with Grant Activity

First Baptist Church has received a grant from the Baptist Health System for \$160,000 to be used over the next two years in developing assistance programs for our refugees. The areas of focus are to be on education and assistance in the arenas of substance abuse (alcohol, drugs, tobacco, and beetle nut), parenting skills, and mental health (anxiety, depression, and trauma). Pilot programs are currently being developed under the leadership of Jon Meyer, Director, and Maureen Jones, Assistant Director. They are leading an Implementation Team consisting of refugee ministry leaders, education leaders, and Burmese leaders. They will soon be looking for group facilitators and other key development volunteers. The results of this work over the next two years could not only greatly impact our refugee families but could have an impact nationally as a model is developed that could be applied to other refugee groups in San Antonio and cities across the United States.

Chainsaw Team Deployment in Support of SBC

The FBC Disaster Relief Chainsaw Team is being deployed by Texas Baptist Men Disaster Relief to participate in Crossover Houston 2013, a pre SBC Convention event.
