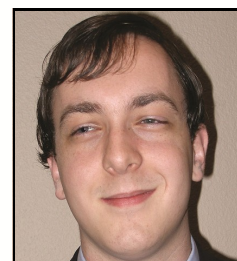

US citizenship eligibility is on the near horizon for some of our International refugees. They must be in the US for five years to be able to apply for US citizenship and several families are at that threshold. Some have already begun studying in preparation for making application and testing. All of our Internationals seem eager to become citizens of their adopted country. The United States will be richer for having these new intelligent and industrious citizens. Be in prayer for them as they approach this exciting phase of their lives. Thailand Mission Trip May 2013

On April 30 Pastor Boun and Dave and Carrie Cole left San Antonio to travel half way around the world to witness in Thailand. Our ultimate destination was a Bible school near the Burmese border. Our goal was to teach the Bible, improve English skills, discuss geography, support and encourage, and expose the students to native English speakers. We taught between 80-100 students each day. Everyone at the school was gracious and welcoming. Many of the students had native language Bibles and read them during worship. We ask for prayer for the students' safety, their salvation and their futures and for the administrator and the teachers as they strive to provide the basic needs of the students. Their enthusiasm and love was inspiring. We thank the church for supporting us on this mission.
