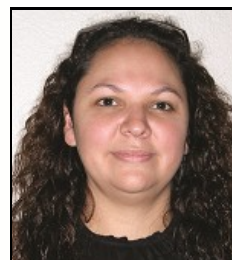

As you have seen on the news recently, there is great unrest in Turkey between the secular (West leaning) populace and the conservative (East leaning) Islamic government. The people of Turkey have set aside a specific time each day that they protest the government's actions (they go outside and shout and beat on pots and pans). The pastors have asked that Christians in America pray each day at 1:00PM for Turkey. This time will coincide with the assigned protest time in Turkey. Pray for God's Spirit to move among the Turkish people.
