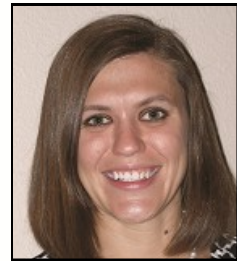

International Students Receive Scholarships

We have had five International students qualify for scholarships to help with college expenses this year. We have been able to increase the number of scholarships awarded because of the generosity of FBC members. To be eligible for a scholarship, a student had to meet a high standard. They had to have a high school grade point average of 80 or above and a high school attendance of 90% or above. They needed to have demonstrated discipleship and service as evidenced by participation as an International Ambassador, service in the youth choir, Sunday School helper or other FBC related service activities. In addition, they needed two letters of recommendation: one from a teacher identifying class participation and industry and one from a FBC International Ministry member. These are \$750 scholarships to assist with the expenses of books. This year's recipients are Jay-U, La Gay La (Lily), Ma Thu Shia, Soe Ner Htoo, and Paw Hsar Eh (Sarah). The official presentation will be made in the 11:00 A.M. worship service on August 11. We are very proud of all of them and their ambition to attend college.

Keep FBC Cool - Update

Phase 1 (structural and electrical work) is underway and nearing completion

Phase 2 (purchase and installation of new heating and air conditioning systems for the Sanctuary and West Hall). The equipment has been ordered.

Project cost: \$1,800,000
Building Fund resources: \$1,480,000
Balance remaining: \$320,000
