Continuing Leadership Training For Internationals

A dozen or more young women from among our Internationals have been participating in a four week leadership study about "Women's Roles in the Church." They learned about such topics as the leadership and financial structure of First Baptist Church. They learned about sharing the plan of salvation, the "Yes, Lord" ministries of FBC, and missions around the world. They learned the practical aspects of being women sharing the Gospel in their homes and neighborhoods. They studied about the woman's role in the home and how it related to leadership within the spiritual community and how such leadership in American Southern Baptist churches was similar as well as how it differed from Burmese Baptist Churches. The study was initiated and organized by Pastor Timothy Ling Saw. He also handled the translation into Burmese. The teaching was done by TJ and Wayne Williams.
