Additionally we are having some great witnessing opportunities. We often have Buddhists in the home worships of our various groups. Two out of the last five weeks we have had our Sunday afternoon Karen youth worship in the apartments of Buddhists. This past Sunday afternoon we had two Muslim teenagers present in the Karen youth worship who were friends of the teenagers of the host family. The world with its mission opportunities has truly come to our doorsteps.
