UKRAINEMISSION REPORT

A few months ago many people with loving hearts helped fund a humanitarian mission to the Eastern edge of the fighting in Ukraine. We are still sending some relief to them and plan another trip in June. These pictures show some of the aid that was sent into the areas hit so hard by the fighting, and one of the greatest needs was diapers and formula for babies. Since many hospitals are closed or are functioning without medicine, some of the support was used to purchase basic medical supplies. In many cases, the only food, water, medicine and heat they get is coming from the local churches, which are being supported by FBCSA. Churches that struggled to reach beyond the doors into the neighborhoods are now filled to capacity on Sundays with people pouring in to hear the Gospel. Churches that went weeks before someone would profess their faith, now see many walking the aisles on Sundays giving their lives to Jesus. Churches are seeing a revival like never before. Please continue to pray that the Ukrainian people will turn to God

for hope, that God will protect the churches so they can work to help the suffering and

helpless people while preaching the Gospel, and protect Ukraine from aggression of its eastern neighbor.
