Deuteronomy 34:1, 4-12

Different attitude toward death

<sup>23</sup>And Jesus answered them, saying, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. <sup>24</sup>Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. <sup>25</sup>He who loves his life loses it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it to life eternal.

## Deuteronomy 34:1, 4-12 (NASB)

<sup>1</sup> Now Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, which is opposite Jericho. And the LORD showed him all the land, Gilead as far as Dan...

<sup>4</sup> Then the LORD said to him, "This is the land which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, 'I will give it to your descendants'; I have let you see *it* with your eyes, but you shall not go over there." <sup>5</sup> So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD. <sup>6</sup> And He buried him in the valley in the land of Moab, opposite Beth-peor; but no man knows his burial place to this day. <sup>7</sup> Although Moses was one hundred and twenty years old when he died, his eye was not dim, nor his vigor abated. <sup>8</sup> So the sons of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days; then the days of weeping *and* mourning for Moses came to an end.

<sup>9</sup> Now Joshua the son of Nun was filled with the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him; and the sons of Israel listened to him and did as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>10</sup> Since that time no prophet has risen in Israel like Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face, <sup>11</sup> for all the signs and wonders which the LORD sent him to perform in the land of Egypt against Pharaoh, all his servants, and all his land, <sup>12</sup> and for all the mighty power and for all the great terror which Moses performed in the sight of all Israel.
