NEW RULES

Luke 24:30-34

New life for Jesus = New life for disciples.

New rules apply.

- Go back to the family (v. 33)

²⁴And let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, ²⁵not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near." (Hebrews 10:24-25)

- We walk by faith (not sight) (v. 31)

"...and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

(Matthew 28:20)

2 Kings 6:17 (Elisha's servant)

- The Bible – True (v. 32)

"... 'O foolish men and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!'" (Luke 24:25)

- Hunger Helps (v. 29)

"So take care how you listen; for whoever has, to him more shall be given; and whoever does not have, even what he thinks he has shall be taken away from him." (Luke 8:18)
