An Old Testament Sign

"The glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle" (v. 35) "God with us."

- New identity
- New Safety
- New priority (decision protocol)

A New Testament Truth

"Those who are being led by the Spirit are the sons of God."
(Romans 8:14)

Acts 16:10 "When he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go into Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them."

What is Required of Us?

- Walking with the Lord
- Waiting on the Lord

The Picture Changed Over Time. Not the Dream.

Revelation 21:2-3

"²And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband. ³And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them."

Exodus 40:1-2, 16, 18-19, 34-38

¹Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, ²“On the first day of the first month you shall set up the tabernacle of the tent of meeting.

¹⁶Thus Moses did; according to all that the Lord had commanded him, so he did.

¹⁸Moses erected the tabernacle and laid its sockets, and set up its boards, and inserted its bars and erected its pillars. ¹⁹He spread the tent over the tabernacle and put the covering of the tent on top of it, just as the Lord had commanded Moses.

³⁴Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. ³⁵Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting because the cloud had settled on it, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. ³⁶Throughout all their journeys whenever the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the sons of Israel would set out; ³⁷but if the cloud was not taken up, then they did not set out until the day when it was taken up. ³⁸For throughout all their journeys, the cloud of the Lord was on the tabernacle by day, and there was fire in it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel.
